1. NEPALESE CLIMBER PURNIMA SHRESTHA CONQUERS MOUNT EVEREST THRICE IN A SINGLE SEASON

- Nepalese climber Purnima Shrestha has achieved the extraordinary accomplishment of climbing Mount Everest three times during the current season.
- She had already climbed eight other 8,000-meter peaks, including the formidable K2 (8,611 m), Kanchenjunga (8,586 m), Lhotse (8,516 m), Makalu (8,481 m), Manaslu (8,163 m), Dhaulagiri (8,167 m), and Annapurna I (8,091 m).
- Additionally, another significant record was set by Kami Rita Sherpa, who achieved the remarkable feat of climbing Everest for the 30th time.
- 2. ALLAMAYE HALINA NAMED NEW PM OF CHAD
- Chad, a north-central African nation, has witnessed a significant transition in leadership as Mahamat Idriss Deby was sworn in as the country's new president.
- > Deby's ascension to power marks the end of three years of **military rule** in the **oil-rich but impoverished nation**.
- Official currency in Chad is the Franc de la Coopération financière en Afrique (Central African CFA) (XAF), and the official languages are French and Arabic.
- 3. SAUDI ARABIA APPOINTS FIRST AMBASSADOR TO SYRIA SINCE 2012
- Saudi Arabia announced the appointment of its first ambassador to Syria since severing ties with Damascus in 12 years.
- Faisal al-Mujfel's appointment as the kingdom's first ambassador to Syria since 2012.
- 4. LITHUANIAN PRESIDENT GITANAS NAUSĖDA RE ELECTED FOR ANOTHER TERM

About Lithuania

- Lithuania is located in north-eastern Europe and is the largest of the three Baltic countries: Estonia, Latvia, and Lithuania.
- They are called Baltic countries because they lie along the Baltic Sea.
- Lithuania became part of the Soviet Union in 1944.
- It became a member of the European Union and the North Atlantic Treaty Organisation in 2004.

7. FRANCE CONDUCTS FIRST SUCCESSFUL LAUNCH OF ASMPA-R NUCLEAR AIRLAUNCHED CRUISE MISSILE

- France conducted the first evaluation firing of its new air launched nuclear cruise missile, the Advanced Medium-Range Air-to Ground Strategic Missile (ASMPAR).
- It is an inertial-guided, air-to surface missile possibly guided by terrainmapping and a preprogrammed onboard computer.
- > The motor assembly includes a solid-propellant engine that turns on after the missile is released from the aircraft.

8. INDONESIA'S MOUNT IBU ERUPTED AGAIN

- > A volcano on the isolated Indonesian island of Halmahera erupted dramatically, shooting a grey ash cloud into the sky.
- Mt. Ibu erupted, spewing ash 4 kilometers (2.5 miles) high and flashing purple lightning around its crater,
- The Ibu volcano is an active stratovolcano located along the NW coast of Halmahera Island in Indonesia.
- > Stratovolcano is also called a composite volcano.
- Ibu's activities follow a series of eruptions of different volcanoes in Indonesia, which sits on the Pacific "Ring of Fire" and has 127 active volcanoes.

9. WORLD CLOCKS MAY SOON SKIP A SECOND AS EARTH SPINS FASTER

- For the first time in history, timekeepers around the world may have to consider subtracting a second from our clocks in a few years, because the planet is spinning a little faster than before.
- Clocks may need to skip a second called a " negative leap second" around 2029, according to a study in the journal Nature
- For thousands of years, the Earth has been generally slowing down, with the rate varying from period to period
- The slowdown is mainly due to the effect of tides, which are caused by the pull of the moon

10. SPAIN JOINS INTERNATIONAL SOLAR ALLIANCE AS 99TH MEMBER

About International Solar Alliance

- India and France conceived the idea of the International Solar Alliance as part of the effort to mobilize the countries to use solar energy to counter global warming and climate change.
- The Indian prime minister Narendra Modi and the French president Francoise Hollande agreed to set up the International Solar Alliance during the sidelines of the 21st Conference of Parties (COP21) to the United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change (UNFCCC) held in Paris in 2015.
- > Members of the ISA
- 119 countries have till date signed the ISA Framework Agreement. 99 countries have ratified and submitted the necessary International Solar Alliance Instrument of Ratification to become a full member.
- Headquarters of ISA: Gurugram , Haryana

11. NORWAY, SPAIN, AND IRELAND TO RECOGNISE PALESTINIAN STATE

- According to the Palestinian Authority, 142 out of the 193 member countries of the United Nations already recognise a state of Palestine. It includes many West Asian, African and Asian countries.
- Algeria was the first country in the world to recognise a two-state solution, the Palestinian state.
- India was amongst the first countries in the world to recognise the Palestinian state.
- 12. IOCL EXPORTS PREMIUM FUEL XP100 TO SRI LANKA
 - Indian Oil Corporation Ltd. (IOCL) has marked a significant milestone by exporting it's first-ever consignment of 100 octane premium fuel, XP100, to Sri Lanka.
 - The high-quality fuel, designed for premium high-end vehicles, was shipped from the Jawaharlal Nehru Port Trust in Mumbai.

13. SERUM INSTITUTE OF INDIA SENT THE FIRST CONSIGNMENT OF MALARIA VACCINE SENT TO AFRICA

- The Serum Institute of India (SII) achieved an important milestone with a shipment of the first set of R21/Matrix-M Malaria vaccine in seven-eight countries in Africa.
- > The flag-off function of R21/Matrix-M [™] malaria vaccine took place in the facility of Serum Institute of India in Pune.
- 14. CHINESE MINISTRY OF COMMERCE IMPOSED BAN ON AMERICAN COMPANIES DUE TO SELLING ARMS TO TAIWAN
 - > The Chinese Ministry of Commerce said that it would prohibit some US companies on imports and export activities related including selling to China, weapons to Taiwan, and would prevent them from making new investment in China.







15. ELON MUSK LAUNCHES STARLINK SATELLITE INTERNET SERVICE IN INDONESIA Elon Musk traveled to Indonesia's resort island of Bali on Sunday to launch Starlink UJI COBA STARLINH satellite internet service in the world's largest archipelago nation. \geq Starlink was launched at three Indonesian health centres on Sunday, including two in Bali and one on the remote island of Aru in Maluku. Indonesia is the third country in Southeast Asia where Starlink will operate. > Neighboring Malaysia issued the firm a license to provide internet services last year, while a **Philippine**-based firm signed a deal with SpaceX in 2022. \geq Starlink is also used extensively in **Ukraine**, where it is employed by the military, hospitals, businesses and aid organisations. 16. MOHAMMAD MOKHBER APPOINTED AS IRAN'S ACTING PRESIDENT Mohammad Mokhber, Iran's first becomes VO) vice president, interim president following the 'tragic' demise of Ebrahim Raisi in a helicopter

- crash. He is expected to serve as caretaker president for some 50 days before mandatory presidential elections in Iran.
- Currently, Ali Khamenei is the Supreme leader of Iran.

17. ARMENIA, AZERBAIJAN AGREE ON DISPUTED BORDER SECTIONS IN NAGORNO-KARABAKH

- Armenia and Azerbaijan had agreed a deal on disputed sections of their shared border, a new step towards normalising ties between the historic rivals.
- > The deal between the two Caucasus nations, both former Soviet republics, includes the return to Azerbaijan of four border villages seized by Armenia in the 1990s.

Background of the Dipute:

- Nagorno-Karabakh is a landlocked area in the South Caucasus that has been the center of a long-running dispute between Armenia and Azerbaijan ever since the Soviet Union broke up.
- The area is mostly made up of native Armenians, but it is officially part of Azerbaijan. Since the late 1980s, there have been random acts of violence in the area.
- Armenia and Azerbaijan fought two wars, in the 1990s and in 2020, for control of the then-contested breakaway region of Nagorno Karabakh.
- Azerbaijan had demanded the return of the four villages as a condition for a peace deal after decades of conflict.

19. HELICOPTER CARRYING IRANIAN PRESIDENT EBRAHIM RAISI 'CRASHES' IN **EAST AZERBAIJAN**

- According to the Iranian news agency, IRNA, Raisi met his Azerbaijani counterpart Ilham Aliyev earlier on 19 May 2024 and inaugurated Qiz Qalasi Dam jointly built by the two sides.
- > Travelling with Raisi was Iran's Foreign Minister Hossein Amirabdollahian, the governor of Iran's East Azerbaijan province and other officials.

20. ANMOL RAI, A TRANSWOMAN CROWNED AS MISS PINK NEPAL 2024 IN, **KATHMANDU**

- > Now, Rai will represent Nepal in the Miss International Queen 2024 competition, to be held in Thailand this year.
- > Miss Pink trans beauty pageant is a traditional pageant for the Nepali transgender community held in Nepal
- > Nepal has become the first country in South Asia to allow same-sex marriage, a step towards implementing gender equality and preventing discrimination towards LGBTQ people.

21. SLOVAKIA PRIME MINISTER ROBERT FICO SHOT AFTER GOVERNMENT MEETING

- #Slovakia's Prime Minister Robert Fico was shot after a government meeting and is being treated in hospital, the country's state news agency reported Wednesday.
- #Fico previously served as Slovakia's prime minister for more than a decade, first between 2006 and 2010 and then again from 2012 to 2018. He was forced to resign in March 2018 after weeks of mass protests over the murder of investigative iournalist

22. MELINDA FRENCH GATES RESIGNS AS GATES FOUNDATION CO-CHAIR

> Melinda French Gates will step down as co-chair of the Bill & Melinda Gates Foundation, the non-profit org. she and her ex-husband Bill Gates founded and built into one of the world's largest philanthropic organizations over the past 20 years.











23. INDIA GRANTS \$ 1 MILLION HUMANITARIAN ASSISTANCE TO FLOOD HIT KENYA

- The government of India has announced humanitarian assistance worth \$ one million to the government of Kenya to deal with the devastation caused by the floods in the country.
- More than 267 people in the country have been killed by the devastating flood, which has displaced more than 3, 80, 00 people in the country.

- It gained independence from England in 1963.

24. RUSSIA'S CONTROVERSIAL OIL AND GAS DISCOVERY IN BRITISH ANTARCTIC TERRITORY

Russia has claimed to have discovered massive oil and gas reserves in the British Antarctic Territory, a region currently protected under the 1959 Antarctic Treaty.

25. CHINA SURPASSES US TO BECOME INDIA'S TOP TRADING PARTNER IN FY24

- Acccording to the latest figures released by the Global Trade Research Initiative (GTRI), in the fiscal year 2024, India's bilateral trade with China totalled \$118.4 billion, with imports rising by 3.24% to \$101.7 billion and exports increasing by 8.7% to \$16.67 billion.
- Conversely, trade between India and the US experienced a slight decline. Two-way trade totalled \$118.3 billion in FY24, with Indian exports dropping by 1.32% to \$77.5 billion and imports decreasing by 20% to \$40.8 billion.
- The UAE, with trade worth \$83.6 billion, was ranked the third largest trading partner of the India, followed by Russia at \$65.7 billion, Saudi Arabia at \$43.4 billion and Singapore at \$35.6 billion.

26. INDIA-OMAN COLLABORATION ON SHARK AND RAY RESEARCH IN ARABIAN SEA

- > To bolster research and conservation efforts concerning sharks and rays in the Arabian Sea, India and Oman are set to embark on a joint initiative.
- This collaboration aims to enhance understanding, promote conservation, and facilitate capacity building in elasmobranch research, with a particular focus on the Arabian Sea region.
- > This workshop, jointly organized by CMFRI and Oman's Marine Science and Fisheries Centre,
- 27. INDIA CONTRIBUTES \$500,000 TO UN COUNTER-TERRORISM TRUST FUND
- India has reaffirmed its dedication to the global fight against terrorism by contributing \$500,000 to the UN Counter-Terrorism Trust Fund (CTTF). Ambassador Ruchira Kamboj, India's Permanent Representative to the UN, delivered the contribution to Under Secretary General Vladimir Voronkov.
- This financial support adds to India's ongoing commitment, totaling \$2.55 million, aimed at bolstering multilateral efforts against terrorism.

28. CHAD MILITARY DICTATOR IDRISSDEBY WIN'S PRESIDENTIAL ELECTIONREPUBLIC OF CHAD

29. EU ADOPTS FIRST LAW AGAINST VIOLENCE TOWARDS WOMEN

- The sweeping law aims to protect women in the 27-nation EU from gender-based violence, forced marriages, female genital mutilation and online harassment.
- > It sets minimum sentences, ranging from one year to five years in prison, depending on the crime.
- > Under the rules, if the victim is a child, spouse or ex spouse, the punishment can be more severe.
- > EU states must transpose the rules into national law within three years.

30. INDIA, 3RD-HIGHEST SOLAR POWER GENERATOR IN THE WORLD, OVERTAKES JAPAN

- > Due to rapid growth in installed solar power capacity, India became the third-largest solar power generator in 2023.
- The 5th "Global Electricity Review" report published by the United Kingdom-based global think tank Ember said that India, which was ranked ninth in 2015, jumped to third position in 2023, overtaking Japan

36. INDIA LODGES PROTEST WITH CHINA OVER ITS INFRA DEVELOPMENT IN SHAKSGAM VALLEY

- India has lodged a strong protest with China for carrying out construction activities in the Shaksgam valley
- Ministry of External Affairs (MEA) spokesperson RandhirJaiswal said that the Shaksgam valley is a part of India and New Delhi never accepted the so-called China-Pakistan boundary pact of 1963 through which Islamabad "unlawfully" attempted to cede the area to Beijing.
- \triangleright The Shaksgam Valley, or Trans Karakoram Tract, is part of the Hunza-Gilgit region of Pakistan-Occupied Kashmir (POK) and is a disputed territory claimed by India but controlled by Pakistan.
- > However, Article 6 of the Pak-China agreement clearly stated that "the two parties have agreed that after the settlement of the Kashmir dispute between Pakistan and India, the sovereign authority concerned will reopen negotiations with the Government of the People's Republic of China, on the boundary as described in Article Two of the present agreement.

37. ALEJANDRA MARISA RODRIGUEZ (60) CROWNED MISS UNIVERSE BUENOS AIRES

- > Alejandra Marisa Rodríguez, 60, has won the title of Miss Universe for the province of Buenos Aires 2024.
- She becomes the first woman of her age to win such a prestigious beauty pageant.
- > The Miss Universe organization last year announced that it would no longer have age limits for pageant contestants.
- 38. HINGLAJYATRAIN PAKISTAN: HINDU PILGRIMS CLIMBED MUD VOLCANOES AS PART OF A THREE-DAY PILGRIMAGE
 - Located in Balochistan'sHingol National Park, HinglajYatra is a three-day pilgrimage and Pakistan's largest Hindu festival.
- Hinglaj Mata Temple is one of the 51 Shakti Peethas in the Shaktism denomination of Hinduism
- More than 1,00,000 Hindus are expected to participate.

39. BRITAIN'S ASTRAZENECA ADMITS THAT ITS CORONA VACCINE 'COVISHIELD' MAY CAUSE RARE SIDE EFFECTS

- > AstraZeneca is facing a class action lawsuit in Britain over claims that its vaccine caused a number of cases of deaths and serious injuries.
- Victims are demanding damages of up to £100 million in 51 cases in the UK High Court.
- British pharma giant AstraZeneca has admitted that its Covid vaccine 'Covishield' may cause rare side effects.
- The vaccine manufacturer has said in court documents that Covishieldcan cause blood clots and lower platelet counts.
- > Covishield, developed by AstraZeneca and Oxford University, was produced by the Serum Institute of India and widely administered in the country during the pandemic.

40. ARGENTINE SCIENTISTS UNVEIL DISCOVERY OF SPEEDY 90-MILLION-YEAR-OLD HERBIVORE DINOSAUR

> Paleontologists from Argentina have revealed the unearthing of a novel medium-sized herbivorous dinosaur, Chakisaurusnekul, which thrived approximately 90 million years ago during the Late Cretaceous period in present-day Patagonia.

- 41. SRI LANKA HANDED OVER THE RENOVATION PROJECT OF 'KANKESANTHURAI PORT' TO THE GOVERNMENT OF INDIA
 - > Recognizing the importance of the project, India has promised to cover the entire estimated cost of the project.
- This decision not only addresses the infrastructural needs of the port but also underlines the strength of bilateral cooperation between Sri Lanka and India.
- Earlier a joint venture between an Indian and a Russian firm has won a 30-year contract to manage Sri Lanka's MattalaRajapaksa International Airport, located near Hambantota.
- > The airport, once described as "the world's emptyest airport"
- 42. TAAMJA' BLUE HOLE (TJBH): WORLD'S DEEPEST BLUE HOLE DISCOVERED IN MEXICO
 - > Researchers have discovered the world's deepest blue hole in Mexico, but they haven't reached its bottom yet.
 - > Located in Chetumal Bay at the southeast corner of the Yucatan Peninsula.
 - > The site named TaamJa' Blue Hole (TJBH) is now the deepest known underwater sinkhole in the world.
- > TJBH extends at least 1,380 feet (420 metres) below sea level.
- 43. UNESCO RECOGNIZES FEMINIST UTOPIAN NOVEL SULTANA'S DREAM AS PART OF "MEMORY OF THE WORLD"
- Sultana's Dream, the utopian novel of a world without men written by Bengali author Begum Rokeya Sakhawat Hossain in 1905 British India (no Bangladesh), has been recognised by UNESCO as part of its Memory of the World Asia-Pacific Committee (MOWCAP)
- The Memory of the World Programme of the UNESCO aims to facilitate preservation of the world's documentary heritage, particularly in areas affected by conflict and/or natural disaster.
- 44. CHINA TO LAUNCH CHANG'E-6 LUNAR PROBE CARRYING PAKISTAN'S ICUBE-Q MISSION
 - China is set to launch the Chang'e-6 lunar probe on a round trip to the Moon, marking a significant advancement in their space exploration.
 - The mission aims to gather soil and rock samples from the far side of the Moon, providing crucial insights into its early evolution and the inner solar system.
 - > Pakistan is set to launch its maiden lunar mission, ICUBE-Q, aboard China's Chang'e-6 probe.
 - Developed in collaboration with China's Shanghai University and Pakistan's Institute of Space Technology (IST), ICUBE-Q carries optical cameras to capture images of the lunar surface.



National News Current Affairs

1. Sanchar Saathi Initiative: Home Ministry & DoT crackdown on fake SMS

- The Department of Telecommunication (DoT), in association with the Union Ministry of Home Affairs, has initiated a strong crackdown on the menace of fraudulent SMS (Short Messaging Service) under the Sanchar Saathi Initiative.
- Eight SMS headers that were being used by cyber criminals to target unsuspecting mobile phone owning customers have been blocked by the government.

Sanchar Saathi Initiative

- **The Sanchar Saathi** Initiative was launched by the Union Communication Minister Ashwini Vaishnaw on 16 May 2023 in New Delhi.
- The Sanchar Saathi portal has been developed by the Department of Telecommunication to empower mobile subscribers, increase awareness about citizen-centric initiatives of the Government and strengthen their security.

2. KIA bags Green Airports Recognition-2024 award

- The Kempegowda International Airport (KIA) has bagged the silver award in the Airports Council International (ACI) Asia-Pacific & Middle East 'Green Airports Recognition (GAR) 2024'.
- > The KIA bagged the silver award in the category of airports handling between 15 million and 35 million passengers a year.
- > The theme for the Green Airports Recognition 2024 is 'Biodiversity and nature-based solutions'.
- > The recognised airports have been awarded in three categories platinum, gold, and silver
- The airports are bracketed into four categories: over 35 million passengers a year, between 15 million and 35 million passengers, between 8 million and 15 million passengers, and less than 8 million passengers a year.
- > The other Indian airports to win the GAR 2024 are:
- > New Delhi's Indira Gandhi International Airport (silver) in airports handling over 35 million passengers a year category and
- Lucknow's Chaudhary Charan Singh International Airport (silver) in airports handling less than 8 million passengers a year category.
- 3. FIRST HYDROGEN PLANT OF GAIL INAUGURATED IN VIJAIPUR, MP
 - The government of India-owned GAIL (India) Limited's first green hydrogen plant has become operational at Vijaipur in Madhya Pradesh.
 - This marks the entry of India's largest natural gas transmission and Distribution Company in the green fuel business.

- 16. FSSAI WARNS AGAINST USING CALCIUM CARBIDE FOR FRUIT RIPENING
 - The Food Safety and Standards Authority of India (FSSAI) has asked traders and food business operators not to use 'calcium carbide' the banned product (under the Regulation of the Food Safety and Standards (Prohibition and Restrictions on Sales Regulations, 2011) for ripening of fruits.
 - Calcium carbide, commonly used for ripening fruits like mangoes, releases acetylene gas, which contains harmful traces of arsenic and phosphorus.
 - There are chances that calcium carbide may come in direct contact with fruits during application and leave residues of arsenic and phosphorus on fruits
 - Can cause serious health issues such as dizziness, frequent thirst, irritation, weakness, difficulty in swallowing, vomiting and skin ulcers, etc
 - Ethylene, a naturally occurring hormone in fruits, regulates the ripening process by initiating and controlling a series of chemical and biochemical activities.
 - About Food Safety and Standards Authority of India (FSSAI)
 - It is an autonomous body established under the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, Government of India.
 - The FSSAI has been established under the Food Safety and Standards Act, 2006, which is a consolidating statute related to food safety and regulation in India.

- 17. SRI SRI RAVI SHANKAR RECEIVES FIRST STAMP RELEASED COMMEMORATING COMPLETION OF 200 YEARS OF INDIAN ORIGIN TAMILS IN SRI LANKA

18. ICMR WARNS AGAINST MISUSE OF NON-STICK TEFLON COOKWARE

- The Indian Council of Medical Research (ICMR) has cautioned that overheating in cracked and scratched teflon-coated nonstick pans can emit large volumes of poisonous fumes and dangerous chemicals into meals (when cooked at a high temperature of over 170 degrees Celsius), potentially causing lung ailments and cancer.
- Hyderabad-based National Institute of Nutrition (NIN), which functions under ICMR has instead asked people to use ecofriendly cookware, such as earthen pots and coating-free granite stone utensils.
- > Polytetrafluoroethylene (PTFE), commonly known as Teflon, is a synthetic chemical comprising carbon and fluorine atoms.
- > It was first created in the 1930s and provides a nonreactive, nonstick, and almost frictionless surface to utensils.

19. ICE CREAM MAN OF INDIA' RAGHUNANDAN KAMATH DIES AT 70

- > Fondly known as the "Ice Cream Man of India", founder of Naturals Ice Cream Raghunandan Srinivas Kamath passed away.
- Kamath first founded the ice cream brand in Mumbai

20. IIT DELHI - ABU DHABI TO COMMENCE ITS FIRST ACADEMIC SESSION IN 24-25

- The first international campus of IIT Delhi will commence its first academic session in 2024-25 in Abu Dhabi, United Arab Emirates (UAE). Initially, the IIT Delhi Abu Dhabi campus will offer undergraduate courses
- IIT Madras has set up a campus in Zanzibar, Tanzania, which commenced its academic season in 2023-24.

22. CENTRE ISSUES FIRST SET OF CITIZENSHIP CERTIFICATES UNDER CAA TO 14 APPLICANTS

23. RAJASTHAN'S FIRST WOMEN MINISTER KAMLA BENIWAL (CONGRESS PARTY) NO MORE FIRST WOMENS

- Shanno Devi was the first woman speaker of a state Legislative Assembly. She was elected the speaker of the Haryana Legislative Assembly(from 6 December 1966 to 17 March 1967)
- The first woman speaker of the Lok Sabha was **Meira Kumar** from 4 June 2009 to 5 June 2014.
- Sarojini Naidu, the Nightingale of India, was the first woman governor of India. She was appointed as the governor of the United Provinces from 15 August 1947 to 2 March 1949. On 26 January 1950, the name of the United Provinces was changed to Uttar Pradesh.
- Sucheta Kriplani became the first woman chief minister of a state when she was appointed as the Chief Minister of Uttar Pardesh (1963-1967).
- Indira Gandhi was the first woman Prime Minister of India. She became the Prime Minister in 1966.
- Pratibha Patil Singh was the first woman President of India (2007 to 2012)
- Amrit Kaur was the first female cabinet minister in India. She was the minister of Health in the Nehru government from 16 August 1947 to 1957.

24. FORMER INDIAN ARMY OFFICER WAIBHAV ANIL KALE KILLED IN RAFAH

Former Indian Army officer, Colonel (retd.) Waibhav Anil Kale was killed in Gaza after his vehicle came under attack in Rafah, Gaza. Waibhav Anil Kale was presently employed with the United Nations as a staff member of the United Nations Department of Safety and Security (DSS) in Gaza.

25. NATION'S BIGGEST SKILL COMPETITION, INDIASKILLS 2024 INAUGURATED

- The four-day nation's biggest skill competition, IndiaSkills 2024, commenced in New Delhi on 15 May 2024. The inaugural ceremony was held at Yashobhoomi, Dwarka, New Delhi.
- The skilling competition will test students' skills across India in 61 categories from 15 -18 May 2024 and offer youth a platform to showcase their talent at national and international levels.
- The four day IndiaSkills Competition 2024 has been organised by the National Skill Development Corporation (NSDC). NSDC is an apex skill development agency under the Union Ministry of Skill Development and Entrepreneurship (MSDE).

26. INDIA TO OPERATE A TERMINAL OF IRANIAN CHABAHAR PORT FOR NEXT 10 YEARS

- India and Iran have signed an agreement under which India will operate the strategically important Shahid Beheshti terminal of Chabahar Port of Iran for the next 10 years.
- Till now India operated the Shahid Beheshti Port of Chabahar on a short term contract which was renewed periodically .This is the first international terminal which will be operated by India.

27. OPERATION SADBHAVANA: INDIAN ARMY'S SUPPORT FOR NORTH SIKKIM'S REMOTE COMMUNITIES

- Under Operation Sadbhavana, the Indian Army's Trishakti Corps demonstrated unwavering support for North Sikkim's remote communities in Naga and Rangrang villages.
- > Following a devastating glacial lake outburst flood (GLOF), the Corps distributed essential relief materials
- > Additionally, a medical camp provided critical healthcare services to over 150 patients

28. EAM DR S JAISHANKAR INAUGURATES ARBITRATION BAR OF INDIA (ABI) IN DELHI

- External Affairs Minister Dr S Jaishankar Inaugurated the Arbitration Bar of India at Bharat Mandapam in New Delhi
- Arbitration is a form of alternative dispute resolution (ADR) that is used to resolve disputes outside of the courts.
- It involves the intervention of a third party, known as an arbitrator, who is chosen by the parties involved in the dispute.

29. BSNL ANNOUNCES TO START 4G SERVICES ACROSS INDIA FROM AUGUST 2024

- In line with the "Atmanirbhar" policy, it will start 4G services across the country from August 2024 using completely indigenous technology. BSNL officials claim to have recorded a maximum speed of 40-45 megabits per second on the 4G network, which has been launched during the pilot phase in the premium spectrum band of 700 megahertz (MHz) as well as in the 2,100 MHz band.
- The company has launched 4G services in Punjab using technology developed indigenously by a consortium led by IT company TCS and state-run telecom research organization C-DOT and has onboarded around 8 lakh customers.









- 30. KRISHIKALP LAUNCHES INDIA'S FIRST ACCELERATOR PROGRAM FOR FARMER PRODUCER ORGANIZATIONS IN BENGALURU
 - Krishikalpa, a non-profit organization, has launched India's first accelerator program for farmer producer organizations in Bengaluru, Karnataka
 - > National Bank for Agriculture and Rural Development, NABARD has provided financial support for this initiative.
 - This will help FPOs to connect to markets and resources. Krishikalpa will also help in developing entrepreneurial skills, supply chain management and providing market orientation training to the members of the FPO.
- 31. SRI LANKA INKS 20-YEAR POWER PURCHASE DEAL WITH ADANI GREEN ENERGY
 - The Sri Lankan government has approved an agreement with Adani Green Energy, led by GautamAdani, for the development of wind power stations in Mannar and Poonerin. The agreement was given the green light by the Sri Lankan cabinet.
 - Under the power purchase agreement, which has duration of 20 years, Adani Green Energy will be paid 8.26 cents per kilowatt-hour (kWh) for the electricity generated from the wind power stations.

32. BORDER ROADS ORGANISATIONTO START WORK ON SHINKU LA TUNNEL

- It is an upcoming motorable tunnel under the 16,580 feet high Shinku-La pass between Himachal's Lahaul valley and Ladakh'sZanskar valley.
- It is located on the Nimmu-Padam-Darcha Road link. The road will be the first all-weather road connecting Ladakh to the rest of the country
- After completion, the 4.1-kilometre-long Shinku-la tunnel will be the world's highest tunnel at 16580 feet, surpassing China's Mila tunnel. The tunnel is likely to be completed by 2025

33. IAF CONDUCTED 'BAMBI BUCKET' OPERATION TO DOUSE NAINITAL FOREST FIRE

- The Indian Air Force had deployed its Mi-17 V5 helicopter to undertake Bambi Bucket operations to douse the forest fires near Nainital.
- > The helicopter used a "Bambi Bucket", also known as a helicopter bucket or a helibucket, to collect water from Bhimtallake, located near Nainital, and poured it over the burning forests.
- > Bambi bucket is a specialised apparatus designed for aerial firefighting purposes and was introduced in 1983.
- > It was invented by a Canadian man, **Don Arney**. In 2017, he was inducted into the Inventors Hall of Fame for this invention
- It allows the helicopters to transport volumes of water underneath the aircraft and disperse it.

- In a major step forward for HIV vaccine development, researchers at the Duke Human Vaccine Institute have successfully induced broadly neutralizing antibodies (bnAbs) against HIV through vaccination for the first time.
- Broadly neutralizing antibodies (bnAbs) are antibodies that can recognize and neutralize many strains of HIV. They have been seen as a potential key to an HIV vaccine but are difficult to produce in humans.

5. INDIA'S ASTROSAT MAKES UNUSUAL DISCOVERY AROUND BLACK HOLE IN DEEP SPACE

- AstroSat, India's first dedicated multi-wavelength space observatory, has made a significant discovery regarding the black hole binary source Swift J1727.8-1613.
- A team of astrophysicists from U R Rao Satellite Centre (URSC), along with collaborators from IIT Guwahati, University of Mumbai, and Tata Institute of Fundamental Research (TIFR), reported this finding in the Monthly Notices of the Royal Astronomical Society (MNRAS).
- This behaviour, called 'aperiodic modulation,' caused X-rays to show a repeating pattern known as Quasi-periodic Oscillations (QPO). This is the first time such a pattern has been observed in this system.

- European Union (EU) Commission has given their final approval to the bloc's Artificial Intelligence (AI) Act, subjecting high-risk AI applications to stricter regulation.
- The EU Commission will have the power to fine companies that breach the AI Act as much 35 million euros (\$38 million) or 7% of their annual global revenues whichever is higher.
- The European Council is one of the seven principal institutions of the European Union (EU) and plays a crucial role in defining the general political direction and priorities of the Union.
- > The AI Act has adopted a risk-based approach subjecting higher-risk AI applications to stricter regulation.
- The law prohibits applications of AI that are considered "unacceptable" in terms of their risk level. Such applications feature so-called "social scoring" systems that rank citizens based on aggregation and analysis of their data
- > They also include applications of AI in financial services and education, where there is a risk of bias embedded in AI algorithms.



- The missile has a launch mass of about 36.8 tonnes and a throw weight of 1,150 kg.
- Bulava has a maximum range of 8,300 km (5,160 miles) and a payload of up to 10 multiple independently targetable reentry vehicles, or MIRVs, capable of delivering nuclear warheads to different targets

9. INDIAN AIR FORCE TESTS BHISHM PORTABLE HOSPITAL FOR AIRDROP IN AGRA

- The Indian Air Force recently conducted a test in Agra for the BHISHM portable hospital, a crucial component of "Project BHISHM" aimed at providing rapid and comprehensive medical assistance during emergencies.
- These portable cubes, part of a broader initiative, can cater to up to 200 casualties, emphasizing swift response and extensive care.

10. INDIA FRENCH MILITARY EXERCISE SHAKTI 2024 TO BE HELD IN MEGHALAYA

- Joint military Exercise Shakti between the Indian and the French forces will be held at the Joint Training Node of the Indian Army in Umroi, Meghalaya. The opening ceremony of the 7th edition of Exercise Shakti
- The military exercise between the Indian Army and the French Army is a biennial exercise which started in 2011 and is conducted alternately in India and France.
- The main aim of the 7th edition of the Shakti exercise will be to develop the capacity of both forces for joint planning on developing strategies and tactics for a war-like situation.
- > Varuna and Garuda Military exercises between India and France
- Hindustan Aeronautics Limited (HAL) and France-based Safran Helicopter Engines SAS have formed a joint venture, Safhal Helicopter Engines Pvt Ltd, to collectively design, develop, certify, produce, sell, and support helicopter engines.

11. CHINA'S 3RD AIRCRAFT CARRIER FUJIAN COMPLETES 8-DAY MAIDEN SEA TRIAL

China's third aircraft carrier, Fujian, has successfully completed its 8-day maiden sea trials. Fujian is an 80,000-tonne supercarrier with electromagnetic catapult for launching aircraft, making China the second country after the U.S. to field a supercarrier with this technology.

12. INDIAN ARMY AND IAF CONDUCT JOINT EXERCISE IN PUNJAB

- The Indian Army's Kharga Corps, under the aegis of the Army's Western Command, successfully conducted a three-day joint exercise with the Indian Air Force (IAF) at multiple locations in Punjab.
- > The exercise aimed to refine processes and validate the employment of attack helicopters in support of mechanized operations in developed terrain.
- The exercise, titled "Gagan Strike-II," incorporated various force multipliers, including Apache and ALH-WSI helicopters, Unarmed Aerial Vehicles (UAVs), and Special Forces of the Indian Army.
- The primary objective was to validate the use of these assets in support of ground offensive operations by strike corps, along with live firing by helicopters as demanded by mechanized forces during offensive maneuvers.

13. ARMY LOOKS AT CREATING NEW UNIT 'OPFOR' TO PLAY ROLE OF ENEMY

IN MILITARY EXERCISES

- The Indian Army is reportedly in the process of establishing a new unit called OPFOR, or "opposing forces," aimed at stimulating adversarial roles during military exercises and wargame training.

1. INDIA'S HIGHEST TRADE DEFICIT WITH CHINA IN THE YEAR 2023-24

- India has recorded a trade deficit, the gap between imports and exports, with nine of its top 10 trading partners, including China, Russia, Singapore and Korea, in 2023-24,
- 2. ACCORDING TO PLFS SURVEY, KERALA IS THE TOP STATE IN YOUTH UNEMPLOYMENT RATE IN THE QUARTER JANUARY-MARCH 2024
 - According to the latest Periodic Labor Force Survey (PLFS) released by the Statistics Ministry, Kerala recorded the highest unemployment rate among the 15-29 age groups in urban areas in the January-March quarter of 2024, while Delhi had the lowest unemployment rate.
 - The survey, which covered 22 states and union territories, identified Jammu and Kashmir, Telangana, Rajasthan and Odisha as other states with high unemployment rates in this age group.
 - The overall unemployment rate for the 15-29 age group was 17 percent for the January-March period, up from 16.5 percent the previous quarter, but slightly lower than the 17.3 percent reported in the same period in 2023.



3. SMARTPHONES BECOME INDIA'S FOURTH LARGEST EXPORT ITEM WITH 42% GROWTH

- The report said that this growth jump could be attributed to the government's successful production-linked incentive (PLI) scheme for the sector.
- It added that <u>PLI</u> in the smartphones segment has pushed India to second position, only behind China, among the world's largest mobile phone manufacturing countries.
- 4. INDIAN STOCK MARKET BECOMES THE 5TH LARGEST STOCK MARKET IN THE WORLD WITH \$5 TRILLION CAPITALIZATION

India's market capitalization has increased to \$5 trillion. This feat was achieved less than six months after crossing the \$4 trillion mark, reflecting the country's strongeconomic resilience and investor confidence.

- 5. INDIA RECORD POSITIVE GROWTH AMONG TOP 5 WORLD STEEL PRODUCER IN APRIL
 - According to the World Steel Association, India is the only country amongst the world's top five crude steel-producing countries to record positive growth in production during April 2024.
 - India, which is the second largest producer of crude steel in the world, recorded a growth rate of 3.9 per cent in April 2024 as compared to April 2023.

- India is the world's **second-largest producer** of crude steel in the world after China.
- India has the distinction of being the **largest producer of sponge iron** in the world.
- After China and the United States of America, India is the world's **third-largest** user of finished steel.

- 8. INDIA'S URBAN UNEMPLOYMENT RATE DECLINES TO 6.7% IN MARCH QUARTER
 - The 22nd Periodic Labour Force Survey (PLFS) conducted by the National Sample Survey Office (NSSO) revealed that the unemployment rate among individuals aged 15 years and above in urban areas of India decreased to 6.7% in the January-March 2024 period.
 - The survey offers insights into various labor force indicators, including unemployment rate, worker population ratio (WPR), and labor force participation rate (LFPR) based on the Current Weekly Status (CWS) approach.
 - The unemployment rate for individuals aged 15 years and above in urban areas saw a slight decline to 6.7% in January-March 2024 from 6.8% a year earlier.
 - Among females aged 15 years and above, the unemployment rate dropped to 8.5% in January-March 2024 compared to 9.2% in the same quarter of the previous year
 - Conversely, among males, the unemployment rate increased marginally to 6.1% in January-March 2024, up from 6% in the corresponding period of the previous year.

Labour Force Participation Rate

- The LFPR is calculated as the percentage of the population in the labor force, comprising both employed and unemployed individuals.
- The LFPR in urban areas for individuals aged 15 years and above rose to 50.2% in January-March 2024, marking an increase from 48.5% in the same period a year ago.

This surge in P-note investments, encompassing Indian equity, debt, and hybrid securities, has been driven by the strong performance of the domestic economy.
- Participatory notes (P-notes) are financial instruments issued by registered foreign portfolio investors (FPIs) to overseas investors who wish to participate in the Indian stock market without registering themselves directly.

12. SETU UNVEILS SESAME, INDIA'S FIRST BFSI-FOCUSED LARGE LANGUAGE MODEL

- Setu, a leading Indian fintech company and part of the Pine Labs Group, has unveiled Sesame, India's first Large Language Model (LLM) specifically designed for the banking, financial services, and insurance (BFSI) sector.

13. RBI LAUNCHES 'FLOATING RATE BONDS' MATURING IN 2034

- The Government of India has introduced a Floating Rate Bond (FRB) maturing in 2034, Reserve Bank of India (RBI) has announced 8% interest rate for the Floating Rate Savings Bond (FRSB) 2034.
- > This bond offers a variable interest rate that **resets every six months**, reflecting market conditions.

I. IMD ISSUES ALERT FOR CYCLONE REMAL

- The India Meteorological Department (IMD) issued a warning for a potential severe tropical cyclonic storm that could impact the coasts of West Bengal and Bangladesh in the next couple of days.
- > This will be the first cyclone developing in the North Indian Ocean basin this year.
- The name 'Remal' is given by Oman


Cyclone

- Cyclones are rapid inward air circulation around a low-pressure area.
- The air circulates in an anticlockwise direction in the Northern hemisphere and clockwise in the Southern hemisphere.
- Cyclones are usually accompanied by violent storms and bad weather.
- There are two types of cyclones:
- 1. Tropical cyclones
- 2. **Extra Tropical cyclones** (also called temperate cyclones or middle latitude cyclones or Frontal cyclones or Wave Cyclones).
- 2. OLDEST KNOWN HUMAN VIRUSES DISCOVERED IN 50,000-YEAR-OLD NEANDERTHAL BONES
 - Neanderthals were an extinct species or subspecies of archaic humans that lived in Eurasia until approximately 40,000 years ago.
 - > Neanderthals coexisted with early modern humans (Homo sapiens) in Europe and Asia for several thousand years.
 - > They were well adapted to cold, glacial environments.
 - Researchers have long wondered if our closest extinct relatives might have succumbed to viral infections that plague modern humans today.
 - > The discovery of ancient DNA from three viruses found in 50,000- year-old Neanderthal bones, unearthed at Chagyrskaya cave in Russia offers new information in this regard.
 - > Based on these results, it seems that Neanderthals were able to get diseases that people get today.
- > Long enough ago that humans could have carried pathogens from Africa and passed them on to Neanderthals in Europe.
- 3. CHINESE POND HERON BIRD SEEN FOR THE FIRST TIME IN UTTARAKHAND
- > For the first time this bird has chosen Kotdwar area of Lansdowne Forest Division for breeding.
- The Chinese pond heron (Ardeola Bacchus) is an East Asian freshwater bird of the heron family. It is one of six species of birds known as "pond herons" (genus Ardeola)
- 4. SCIENCE ALERT: 'DOOMSDAY GLACIER' MELTING AT A TERRIFYING RATE
 - Antarctica's "Doomsday Glacier" is melting twice as faster than scientists previously thought, because of warm ocean water that is infiltrating miles beneath its surface
 - The Thwaites Glacier, which is nicknamed the Doomsday Glacier because of its potential to massively increase sea levels is located in West Antarctica. It is one of the world's fastest-changing and most unstable glaciers.
 - Previous research found that the glacier has been melting rapidly since the 1980s contributing to a 4% rise in global sea levels with the loss of hundreds of billions of tons of ice.

▶ If the glacier completely melted, it could raise sea levels by as much as 2 feet (60 centimeters).

NEW JUMPING SPIDER SPECIES DISCOVERED IN SHENDURNEY WILDLIFE SANCTUARY

- Researchers from Kerala and Tamil Nadu has discovered two new species of jumping spiders in Shendurney Wildlife Sanctuary (Kerala) in the southern Western Ghats.
- > The new species are Habrocestum shayadri and Irura Shendurney
- The findings have been published in the peer-reviewed European Journal of Taxonomy
- NO MINING WITHIN 1-KM RADIUS AROUND TIGER HABITATS: SC TO RAJASTHAN
 The Supreme Court told authorities in Rajasthan that there cannot be any mining activity within 1-km radius of critical
 - tiger habitats.
 The court, in a judgment, had said that mining within 1-km from the boundary of a national park or a wildlife sanctuary shall not be permissible. It added, "as such the prohibition... will be automatically applicable even to the critical tiger reserves".
 - According to the court, Section 38XA of Wildlife Protection Act 1972 shows that tiger reserves stand on a higher pedestal than wildlife sanctuaries and national parks.

The Sariska Tiger Reserve

- It is located in the Alwar district of Rajasthan.
- It is well nestled in the Aravali Hills, covering an area of 800 sq km.
- Sariska was declared a wildlife sanctuary in 1955 and was declared the tiger reserve later in 1978, making it a part of India's Project Tiger.
- It is the first reserve in the world to successfully relocate tigers.

7. ANCIENT BRANCH OF NILE RIVER UNCOVERED NEAR EGYPTIAN PYRAMIDS

- For many years, archaeologists have thought that ancient Egyptians must have used a nearby waterway to transport materials such as the stone blocks needed to build the pyramids on the river.
- A research team from the University of North Carolina Wilmington has discovered that the pyramids are likely to have been built along a longlost, ancient branch of the River Nile - which is now hidden under desert and farmland.
- The river branch named the Ahramat branch, with "ahramat" meaning pyramids in Arabic - was roughly 64km (39 miles) long and between 200-700m (656-2,296 ft) wide.
- The Ahramat branch flowed near a staggering 31 pyramids, including the iconic Giza pyramid complex. This close proximity indicates that the river served as a vital transportation route.
- The River Nile was the lifeline of Ancient Egypt and remains so to this day.
- > The longest river in the world and is called the father of African rivers.

8. UAE LAUNCHES 10-YEAR BLUE RESIDENCY VISA FOR ENVIRONMENTALISTS


- > The UAE Cabinet has announced a new 10-year Blue Residency visa for individuals who have made exceptional contributions to protecting the environment.
- > This includes members of international organisations, international companies, associations, non-governmental organisations, and global award winners.
- The visa has been introduced in alignment with the national directives declared by UAE, to designate 2024 as the year of sustainability.

9. SEI WHALES RETURN TO ARGENTINA AFTER CENTURY

- Giant blue-grey sei whales that vanished from Argentina's Patagonian coast a century ago due to hunting are starting to flourish once again, demonstrating how species can recover when measures to protect them are put in place.
- During the 1920s and 1930s, sei whales faced intense hunting pressure, primarily from whaling operations in and around Argentine waters.
- Sei whales, scientific name "Balaenoptera borealis," are the third largest rorqual after blue and fin whales.

10. DRY ARAL SEA HAS MADE CENTRAL ASIA DUSTIER, WITH IMPACTS ON GLOBAL CLIMATE, SAYS STUDY

- The Aral Sea, the world's fourth-largest lake until the early 1960s, dried up after that decade in Soviet Central Asia and became a byword for environmental disaster later, almost on the lines of the Chernobyl nuclear disaster.
- The Aral was fed by the two great rivers of Central Asia the Amu Darya (Oxus in Antiquity) and the Syr Darya (Jaxartes) — flowing from the Pamir and Tien Shan mountain ranges of High Asia, respectively.
- Now, a new study has found that the desert which emerged due to the drying up of the lake, has made Central Asia a much dustier place.
- "The drying up of the Aral Sea has made Central Asia dustier by 7 per cent over the past 30 years. Between 1985 and 2015, dust emissions from the growing desert almost doubled from 14 to 27 million tonnes.

1. SUPREME COURT BANS ED'S ARREST POWERS AFTER TAKING COGNIZANCE OF SPECIAL COURT

- The Supreme Court ruled that the Enforcement Directorate (ED) loses the power to arrest an accused after a special court takes cognizance of a charge sheet filed under the Prevention of Money Laundering Act (PMLA).
- The decision significantly curtails the ED's power to arrest persons not detained during the investigation phase under the PMLA.
- After taking cognizance of the offense punishable under Section 4 of PMLA, the special court takes over the case.



- The court said it cannot accept a situation where the accused is not arrested before lodging the complaint, but after the complaint is lodged and the person appears in compliance with the summons of the trial court, he is taken into custody and forced.
- Such a practice **may violate the right to freedom** guaranteed by Article 21 of the Constitution of India.
- The origin of this Directorate goes back to 1st May, 1956, when an 'Enforcement Unit' was formed in the Department of Economic Affairs for handling Exchange Control Laws violations under Foreign Exchange Regulation Act (FERA), 1947.
- > It was headquartered in Delhi, headed by a Legal Service Officer as the Director of Enforcement.
- It had two branches at Bombay and Calcutta.
- In the year 1957, this Unit was renamed as 'Enforcement Directorate', and another branch was opened at Madras (now Chennai).

What is the Structure of ED?

- Hierarchy: The Directorate of Enforcement, with its headquarters at New Delhi, is headed by the Director of Enforcement.
- There are five regional offices at Mumbai, Chennai, Chandigarh, Kolkata and Delhi headed by Special Directors of Enforcement.
- It functions under the Department of Revenue of the Ministry of Finance.
- Rahul Navin, a 1993-batch IRS officer, has taken charge as the acting director of the ED replacing Sanjay Kumar Mishra, an IRS officer of the 1984 batch.
- <u>Composition:</u> It is composed of officers from the Indian Revenue Service, Indian Police Service and the Indian Administrative Service as well as promoted officers from its own cadre.
- <u>Objective</u>: The Organization is mandated with the task of enforcing the provisions of two special fiscal laws Foreign Exchange Management Act, 1999 (FEMA) and the Prevention of Money Laundering Act, 2002 (PMLA).
- Processing cases of fugitive/s from India under the Fugitive Economic Offenders Act, 2018.
- Adjudicating show-cause notices issued under the repealed FERA (Foreign Exchange Regulation Act, 1973).
- Sponsoring cases of Preventive Detention under the Conservation of Foreign Exchange and Prevention of Smuggling Activities Act, 1974 (COFEPOSA) with respect to FEMA violations.

2. INDIA PROPOSES DIGITAL COMPETITION BILL, 2024

- Ministry of Corporate Affairs (MCA) has proposed a new digital competition law that could stop tech giants like Google, Facebook, and Amazon from self-referencing their own services, or using data gathered from one company to benefit another group company.
- > The draft law is called the Digital Competition Bill, 2024.
- It has provisions to set presumptive norms to curb anti-competitive practices before they actually take place, and promises to impose heavy penalties — which could amount to billions of dollars — for violations.
- > The proposal is similar to the European Union's Digital Markets Act (DMA), which went into complete effect earlier this year.
- Currently, India follows an ex post antitrust framework under the Competition Act, 2002. Regulating after the incidence of market abuse involves delays— by the time the offending company has been penalized, market dynamics change to rule out smaller competitors.
- The proposed framework is a forward-looking, preventive, and presumptive law (an ex ante framework)
